Bag Guideline: One duffle or small carryon size bag.

What to wear on the Bus: Wear running clothes for your warm-up/pre-race. We will go straight to Woodward Park for course preview and pre-race. Very tight time schedule.

What to bring: Uniform, running clothes, warmups, shoes, running watch and socks for 2 runs for all weather. Casual comfortable clothes for the drive home.
